Concept Note

Islamic law is one of the longest enduring and most widely practiced systems of law in the world. At the same time, however, it is one of the most maligned and misunderstood the system

of law. The present workshop will offer listeners a firm grounding in the principles, concepts, and terminology of Islamic law, as well as its role in the contemporary era. Through discussions of both practice and theory, as well as interactive exercises, participants will gain practical insights into the sources and constructs of religious-based legal system, including the substantive difference between Shari'ah and jurisprudence, analysis of the Qur'an, Traditions of Prophet Muhammad, the Schools of law, differences between Shia and Sunni Islamic law, the advent and growth of Islam and modern resurgence of Islamic law and Islamic political movements. Participants will also gain an in-depth understanding of selected aspects of Islamic constitutionalism, Islamic criminal law, and not only how classical and contemporary Islamic law comports with international human rights law, but also how Islamic law can be misapplied and misunderstood. This National workshop will use real-world examples and interactive exercises throughout, in order to give listeners a practical understanding of these concepts, as they apply today.
