Aliah University is an autonomous university under the Department of Minority Affairs and Madrasah Education, Government of West Bengal. About the Department

The Department of Education, Aliah University was established in 2014 and started its journey from 21, Haji Md Mohsin Square, Kolkata-16, and in 2017 it shifted to Park Circus Campus of the University. The department offers two-year B.Ed. programme (NCTE recognised) with an intake capacity of 100 each year. The aim of this programme is to provide opportunities for trainee students to extend as well as deepen their knowledge and understanding of education in any two of the area of specializations in pedagogical subjects such as Language Education (Arabic, Bengali, English, Urdu, & Persian), Mathematics Education, Science Education, and Social Science Education. Guidelines for Paper Submission

The full paper should be written within 2500 to 3000 words excluding references and abstract, typed in MS Word in Times New Roman with 12 font size, 1.5 line spacing and left alignment. The cover page should contain: Theme and sub-theme, Title, Author(s), Affiliation, Email address(es) and WhatsApp Number(s).

The abstract should be of 500 words and should reflect objectives, method, major findings, result and major implications. The full original paper along with abstract should be organized in the following format: Abstract, Key words, Introduction, Objectives, Hypotheses (if any), Methods and Procedures, Results and Discussion, Conclusion, References. References should follow APA 7th edition, 2020 format.

- ✓ **Abstract of all registered participants will be published in an abstract volume.**
- ✓ **Publication opportunity in an edited book with ISBN number from a reputed national/international publication house.**
