Each abstract/full paper should contain **title**, **subtheme**, **author name** and his/her **designation**, **affiliation**, complete **mailing address** along with his/her **WhatsApp** number and **email-ID**. **Research papers fulfilling all publication criteria will be published in a book form with ISBN after the Seminar.**
